- Provide numerous examples of outstanding contributions to the general welfare of classified school employees.
- Have they served on the Board of Directors? Legislative Council? State Committees?
- What special accomplishments did this person achieve?
- What new programs or significant changes were created under this person's leadership?
- Have they completed a "lifetime" of achievements?

Legislative Member of the Year

- Have they attended legislative conference on a regular basis?
- What political campaigns have they worked on?
- Have they lobbied in Olympia? Served as a legislative intern?

Honorary Member of the Year (Not for PSE members)

- Has this person been in a position to improve conditions for classified? How?
- What was the impact?
